**ORDER**


At a case management conference before Mr. Justice Edward Belobaba on November 7, 2012, the Plaintiffs requested that a court-ordered scheduling order be entered to govern the timing of the next steps in this action. All parties consented to the schedule proposed by the Plaintiffs.

THEREFORE:

1. THIS COURT ORDERS that the below schedule be followed by all parties to this action:
  - a. December 1, 2012: Plaintiffs file their second amended statement of claim
  - b. January 31, 2013: Defendants file their amended statements of defense, if any
  - c. February 7, 2013: Plaintiffs file their motion to bifurcate and Defendants file pre-discovery motions, if any
  - d. March 15, 2013: Defendants file responses to motion to bifurcate, if any
  - e. April 1, 2013: Hearing on motion to bifurcate, if required
  - f. Mid-April 2013: Case management conference to schedule discovery issues

2. THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that leave is granted to all parties to file amended pleadings if they elect to do so. This includes leave for the filing of a second amended statement of claim by the Plaintiffs and amended statements of defense by the Defendants.
3. THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that it is expected, based on statements made by counsel at the case management conference of November 7, 2012, that the Plaintiffs' motion to bifurcate shall be unopposed; a decision on granting that motion shall be reserved, however, until all parties have had an opportunity to review the Plaintiffs' submission and determine if they consent.
4. THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that if the matters scheduled above are completed more quickly than anticipated, the case management conference scheduled for mid-April 2013 may be advanced on the request of any party.
